Unit	My Mother at Sixty-Six(Flamingo-Poetry)
Class Transaction	Total: 3 periods
Pre-requisite for the course	Students would be asked to share their moments with their mothers. They would be shown the importance of mother in their lives.

## DAY PLAN

### Anticipatory Set-

- The facilitator will ask the learners a few basic questions to introduce the topic
- What are the common childhood fears?
- What are the common pains and sufferings, old people undergo?
- What sort of relationship do a mother and a daughter have?

### Objective –

- The students will be able to understand the theme of the poem-complex subtleties of human relationship. They will be able to understand the warmth in a relationship.
- They will be able to understand the sense of inner guilt for not being by our elder's side.

### Techniques to be used-

- Group discussion
- Debate
- Interactive learning
- Problem solving

### Materials required and teaching aids-

Instructional aid- Digital modules, smart class(clips on mother-child bonding), Flamingo, chalk and duster, black board

Strategy-

Student- teacher interaction/discussion, collaborative learning, independent practice

### Day 1 &2

Activity 1 : The facilitator will initiate/draw the student's attention to the topic by asking questions like :

#### *(Communication and brainstorming)*

- What are the major problems that our elders undergo?
- How do we describe the appearance of an old lady?

#### Activity 2: *Communication*

- Model reading of a stanza by the teacher.
- Silent reading by children.
- Understanding the lesson with the help of word meanings, using dictionary.
- Discussion on the theme of the poem.
- Discussion on the use of literary devices in the poem.

### Guided Practice

The students will write a paragraph on ' Mother-Daughter Relationship'.

### Summarize and check for understanding

Rapid fire questions will be asked to check the comprehension skills of the students and doubts cleared.

### Day 3(*Critical thinking and problem solving*)

Recap of the last day and other contextual questions will be done in the notebooks with the assistance of the teacher.

The students will be explained the importance of family bond and strengthening of relationships.
